* Field performance data came from recent Michigan Wheat Performance Trials, private breeders and Uniform Eastern Red Nurseries while the milling quality resulted from the publications and in-house evaluation of The Mennel Milling Company. Field yield score: 5 - 1 (112.8 - 82.4 bu/ac for 2 years and 107.5 - 78.7 bu/ac for 3 years); Test weight score: 5 - 1 (61.4 - 53.9 #/bu for 2 years and 61.7 - 54.4 #/bu for 3 years). Milling quality score: 5 - 1 from the best to the poorest; Maturity: E = early, M = medium, L = late; Scab resistance: MR = moderately resistant, M = medium resistance.
